Guidelines for the 2019

Eligibility

- Postgraduate students enrolled in the Science or Engineering program or researchers categorized at the National Research System (SNI) at the starting level or level 1.
- GPA: 4.0 and above (Out of a possible 5.0)
- Meets the following English language requirements (An official test score must be submitted unless the student is exempted for reasons found in the KIST Internship Application Guidelines (Native English speakers or students who studied longer than 2 years in the English speaking country can be exempted from submission of English proficiency score):

Duration: 1-6 months, beginning October of 2019 (max)

Included in the Scholarship

- Monthly stipend of 1.200 USD (USD 1000 are covered by ANII and the extra 200 are covered by KIST)
- Round trip, economy-class airfare to and from the student’s country of residence
- Dormitory facilities
- Free tuition

List of Required Documents

Scanned version of all required documents must be submitted by application deadline to e-admission system of KIST School. After announcement of successful candidates, Original version of all required documents must be submitted to KIST School Secretariat on the first day of Dual Degree Program.

- After submitting the application, if there is a change in academic status like expulsion and withdraw and student do not notify his or her changed status to KIST School secretariat, KIST School can cancel the admission or terminate internship.
- If all required documents would not be submitted, then will be considered to fail at the formal examination in the first selection.
- All application documents should be written in English. Documents not written in English must be accompanied by certified translations (or documents notarized at embassy).
